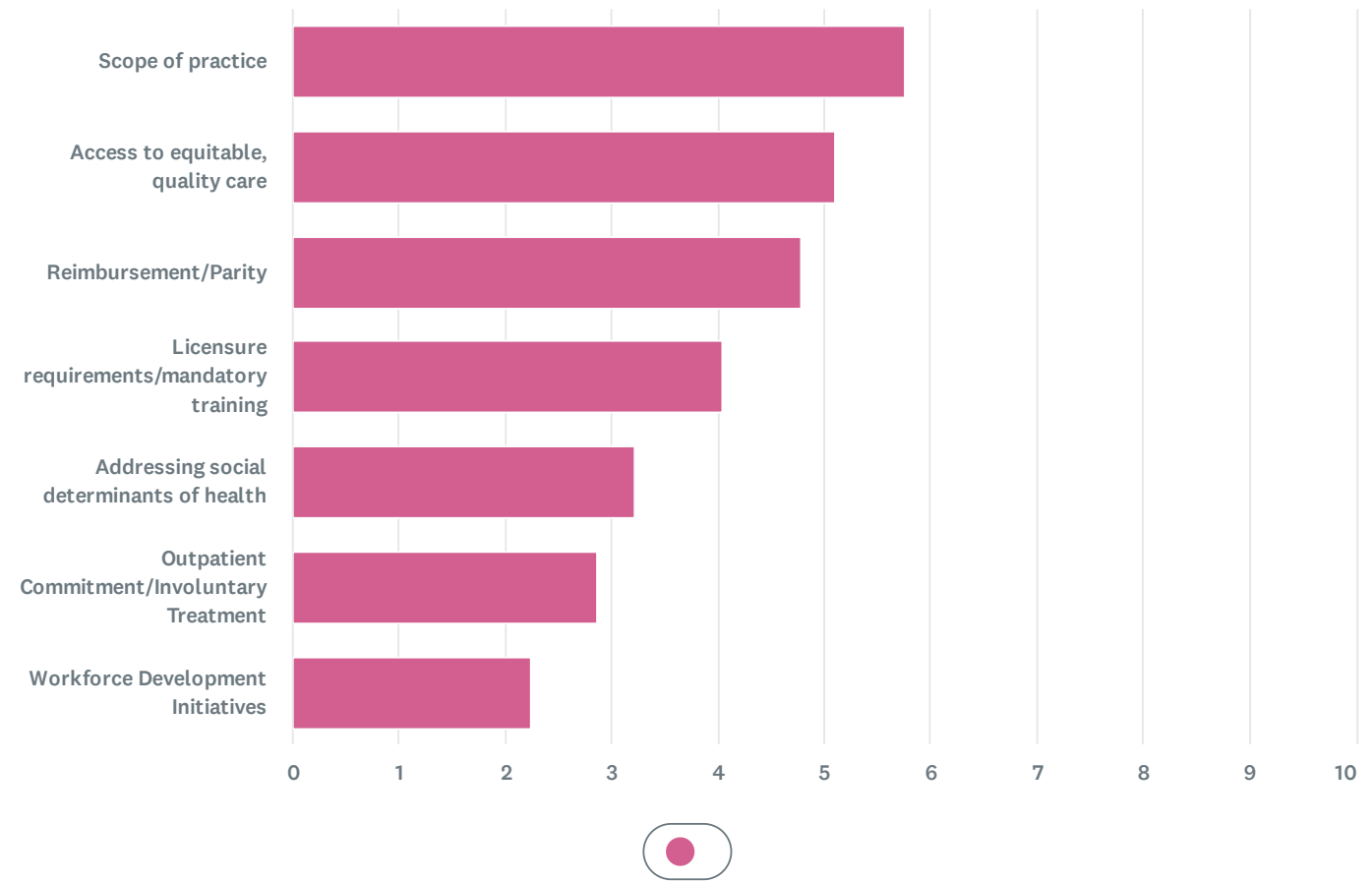

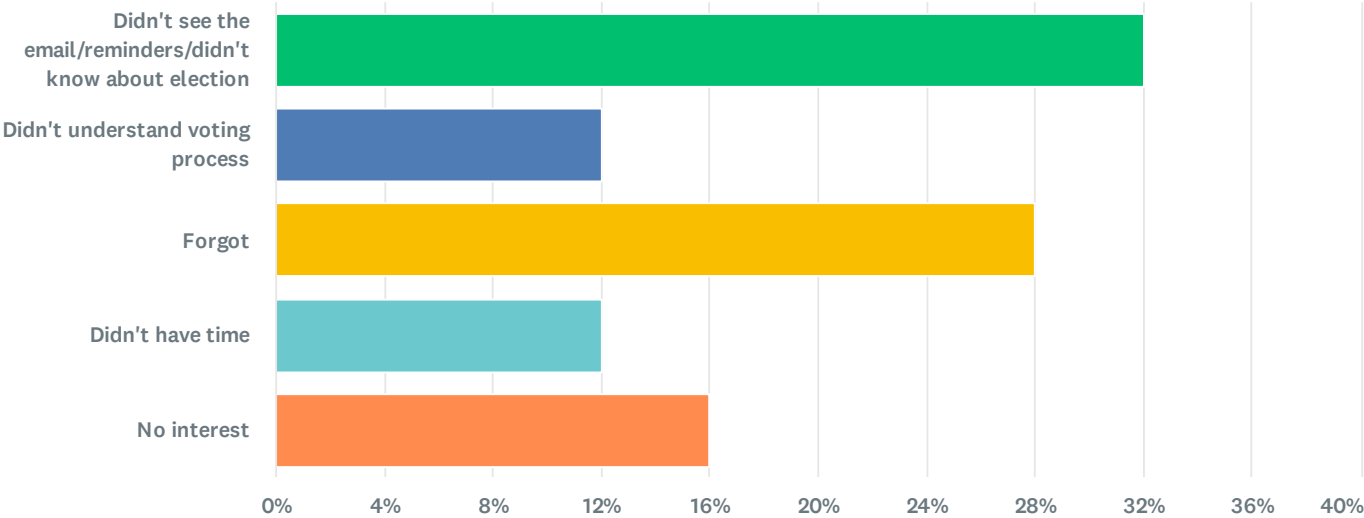
Q6 84 responses

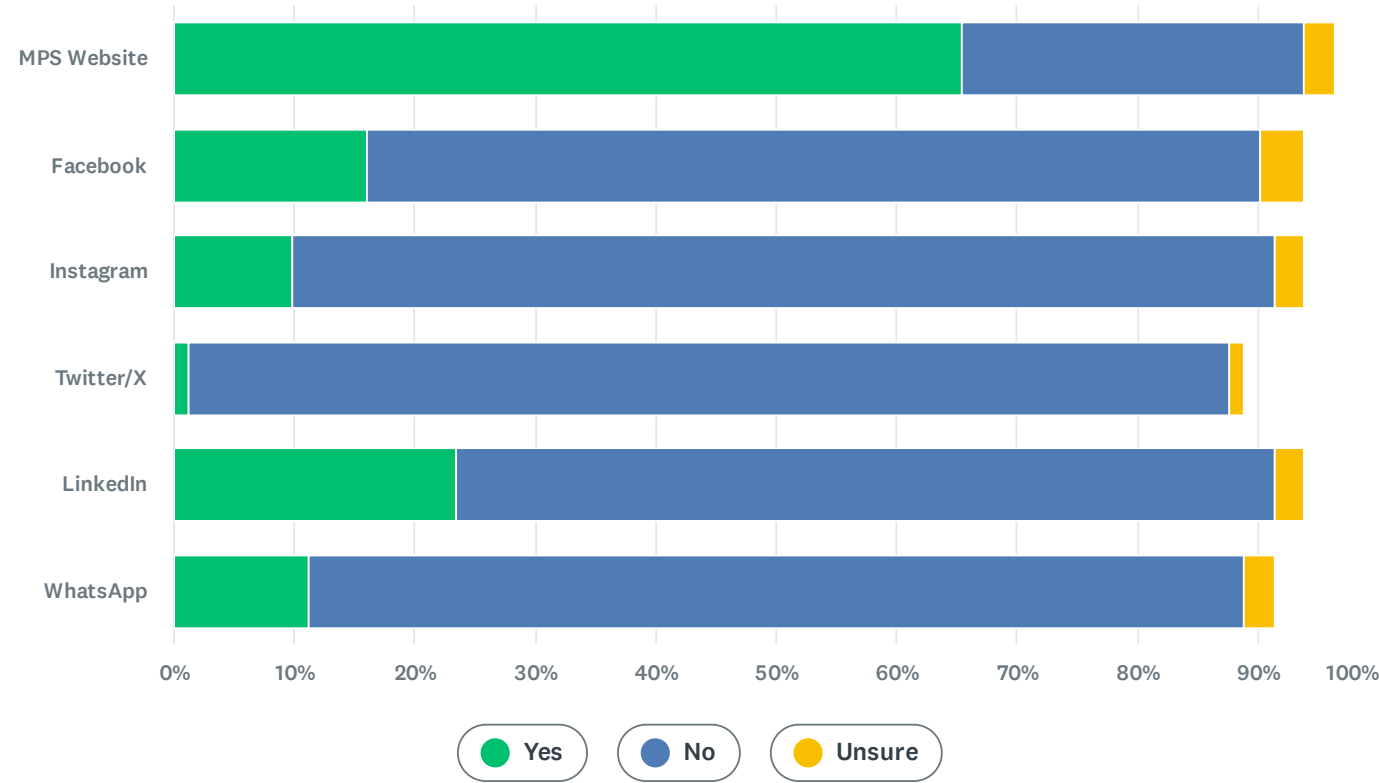

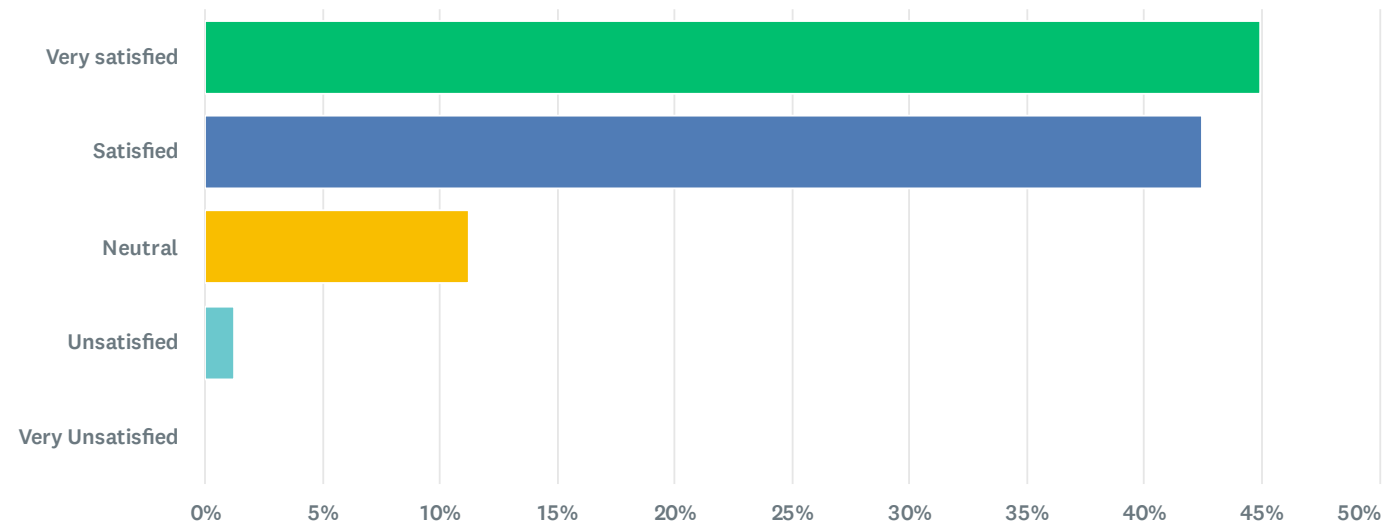

Have you visited/used/interacted with the following MPS social media platforms in the past year?



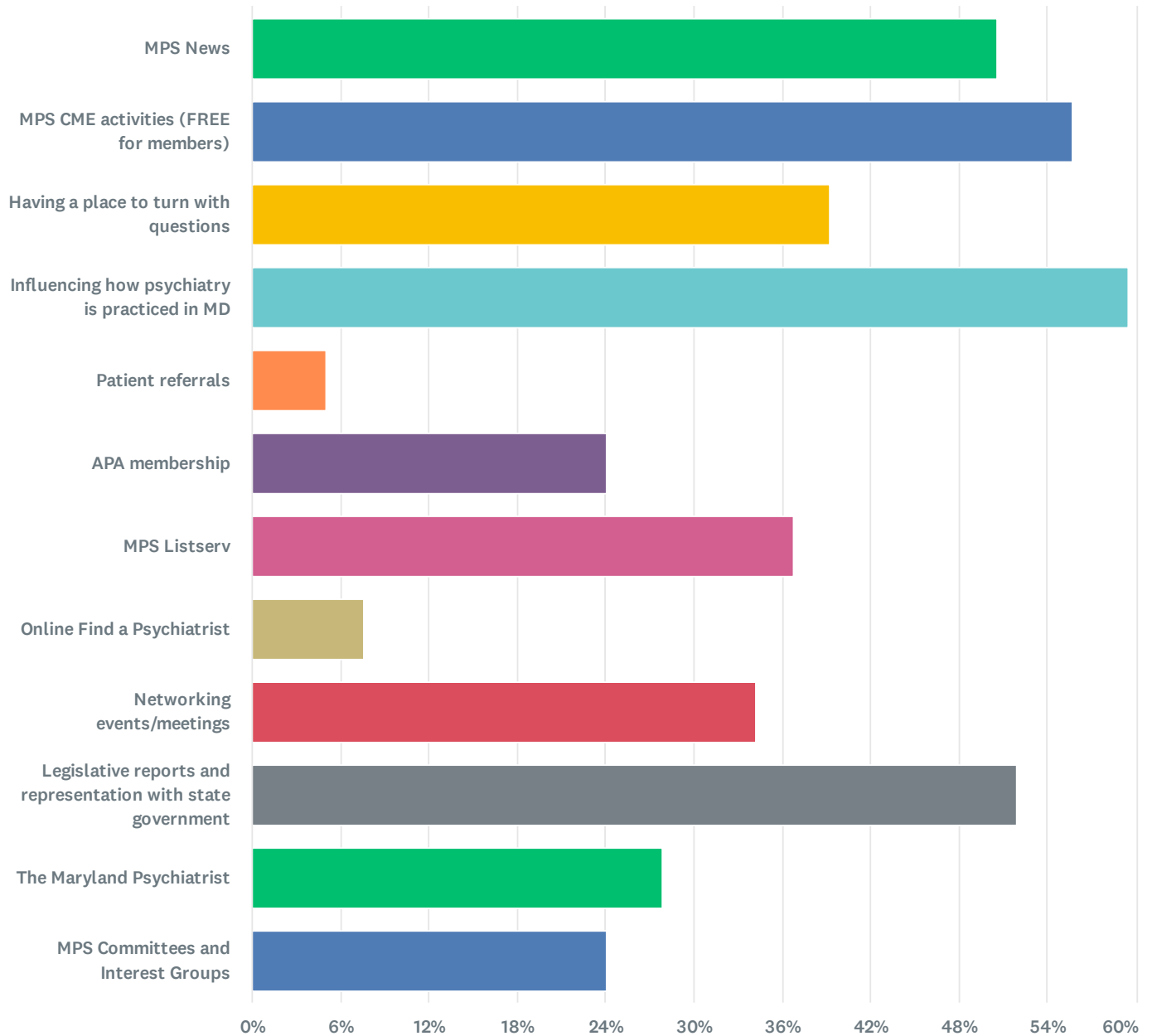

What is your overall level of satisfaction with the MPS?



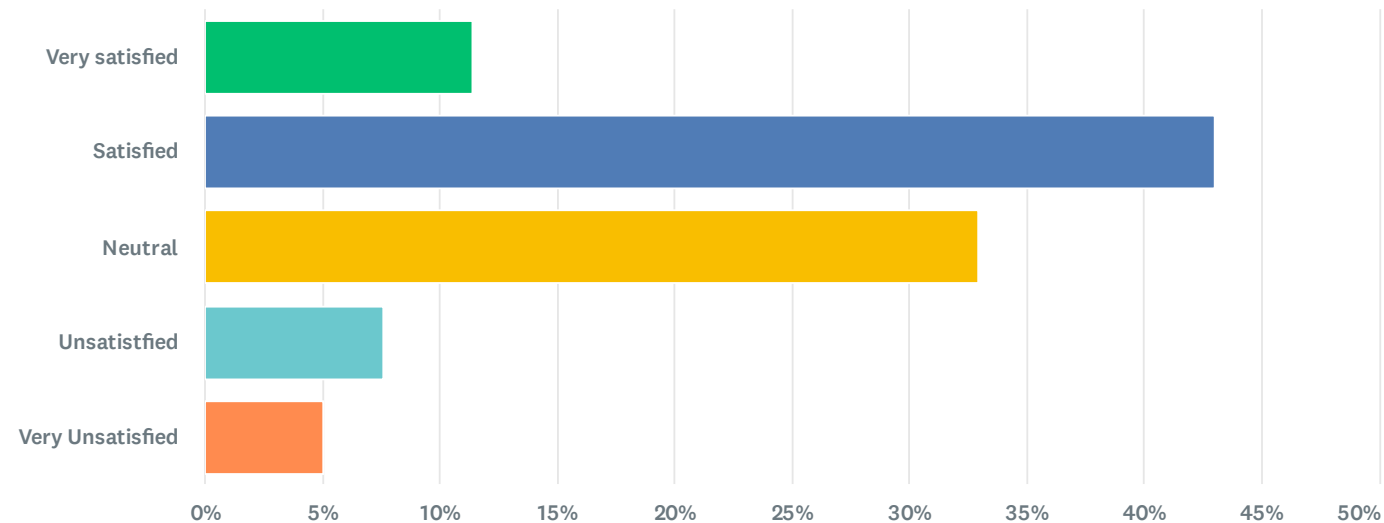

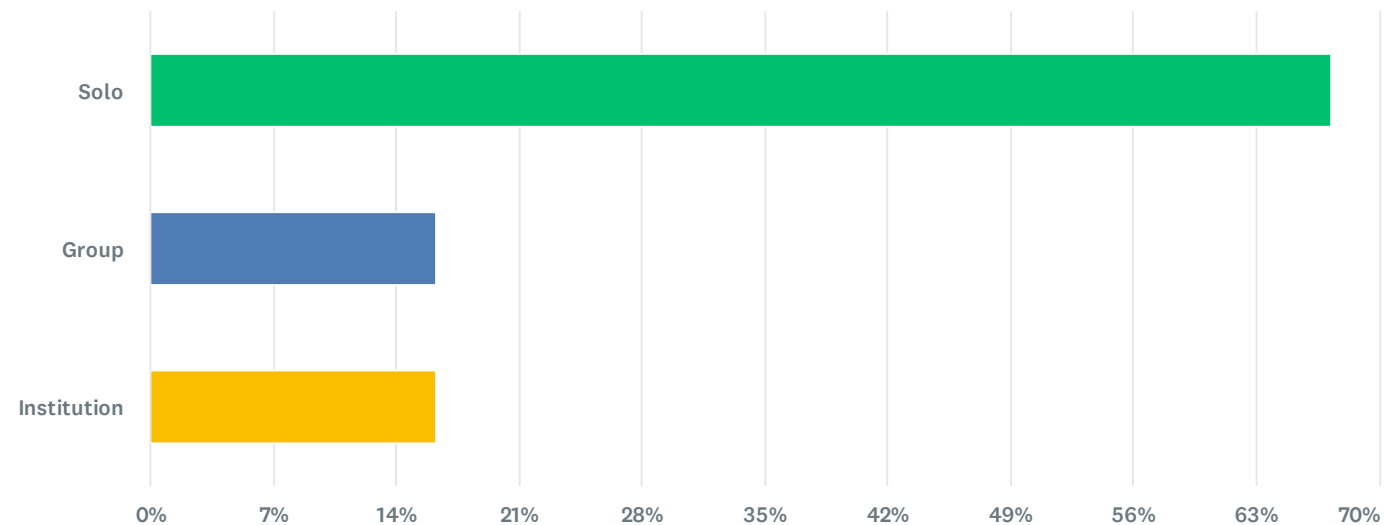

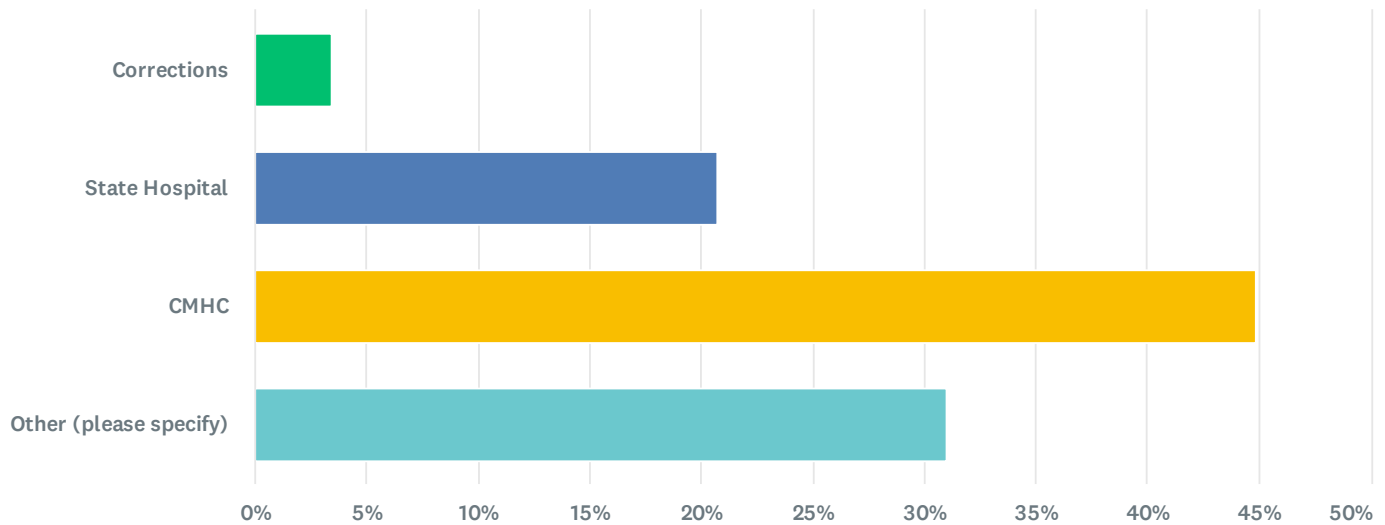

If you work in the public sector, is it

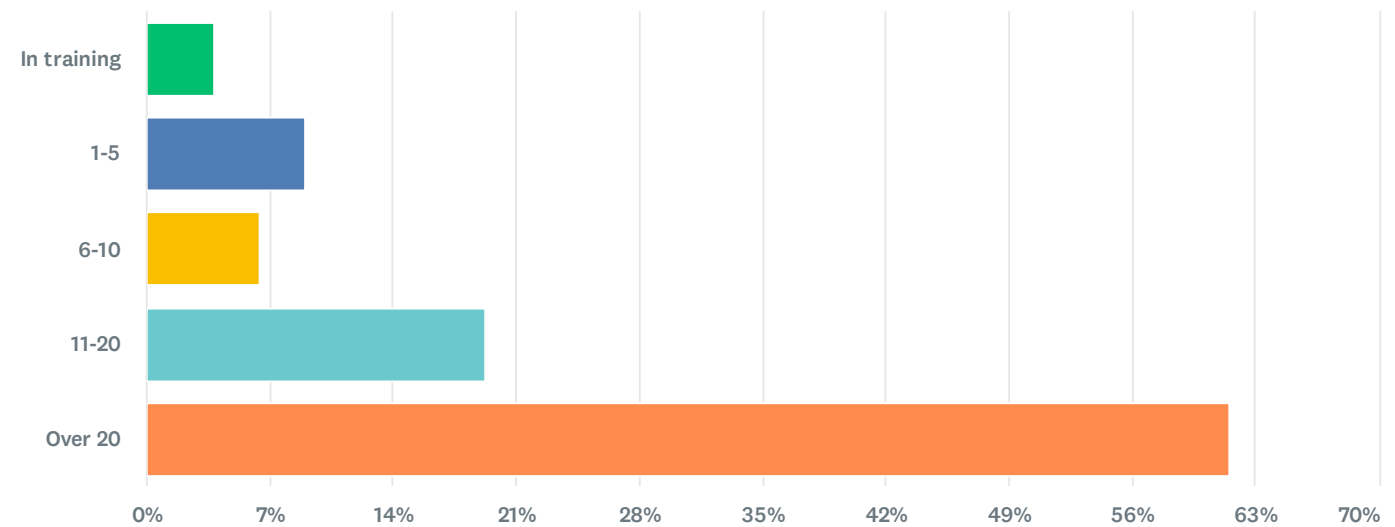

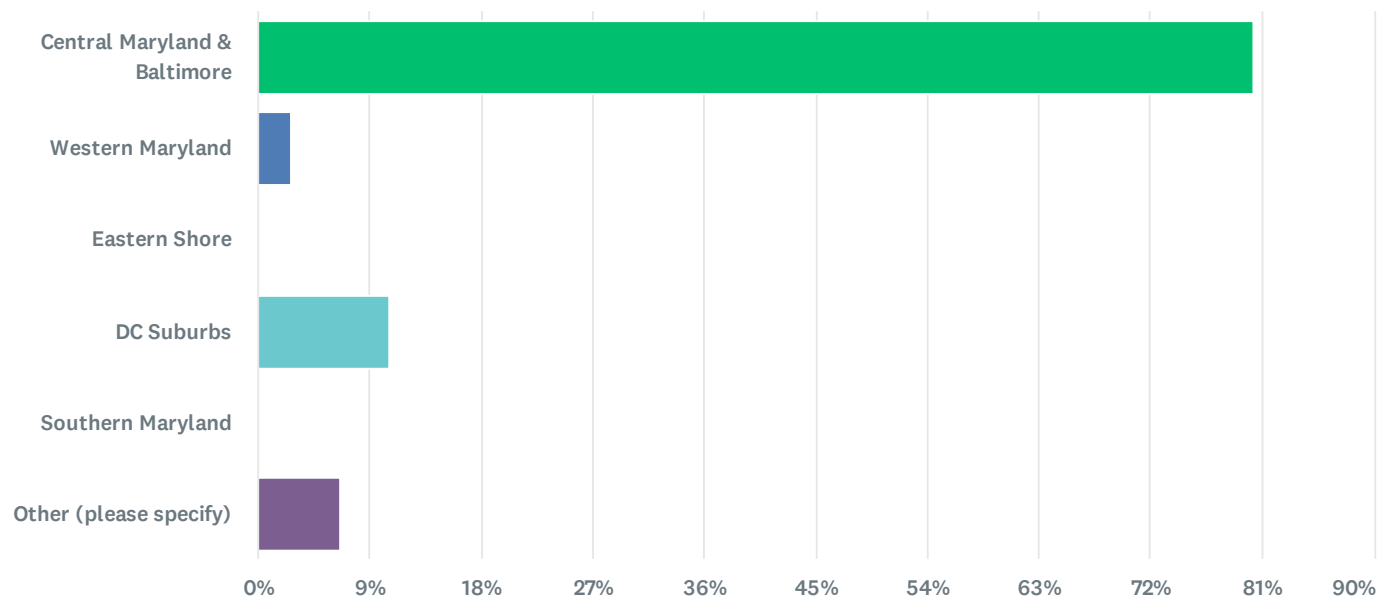
