The Maryland Psychiatric Society, which represents over 700 psychiatrists across the state, offers comments in response to the December 6 proposed change to **31.10.21 Private Review Agents**. We recommend the following revisions to the change that adds ASAM criteria to the uniform treatment plan form:

- To improve clarity, the wording of the instructions for the low-medium-high ASAM grid should be changed from "...rate the patient's current status on these conditions..." to "...rate the patient's current severity/risk and current need for treatment services intensity on these Dimensions... "
- 2. In addition, after the grid, include free text space to "add details or explanation as needed" for each dimension.
- 3. In the interest of eliminating redundancies and reducing paperwork and provider burnout, we recommend adding a sentence to the "Current Symptoms and Functional Impairments" section on page 1 as follows:
 - "If this request is for Substance Use Disorder authorization, skip this section and complete the Substance Use related section on page 3 instead."
